CLE installs changing art exhibit in terminal, issues Call to Artists for temporary art

Cleveland, Dec. 18, 2009 – Cleveland Hopkins International Airport (CLE) is issuing a call to artist to submit proposals for its planned changing art exhibit in two of its concourses. The 2010 Themes, for the changing exhibit will capture the true essence of Northeast Ohio region as well as capture the rich diversity and artistry of the arts community. **The deadline for artists' submissions is 4 p.m. Friday, March 12, 2010.**

“As with the Terrazzo art project, the changing art exhibit is meant to showcase the many talented artists in the Northeast Ohio region,” said Airport Director Ricky Smith. “These temporary art exhibit locations will be in high passenger traffic areas and be seen by upwards of 30,000 airport users daily.”

There will be two locations in the airport featuring the changing artwork, including:

- The wall display area entering Concourse A
- Two locations in the Concourse D tunnel – a wall display and floor area to feature eight standing floor pieces.

The CLE Temporary Art Exhibit Program requirements must include the following:

- Completed and signed CLE Temporary Art Exhibit Program application
- One CD with digital photos of full exhibit (please include name and exhibit title)
- Identify the theme you are submitting for
- A brief written statement explaining how the submission correlates to the theme
- A self-addressed stamped envelope if artist would like proposal returned

Artists submitting proposals for the CLE Temporary Art Exhibit Program will be judged on:

- Capturing the vision of the theme
- Cultural, educational and/or artistic merit
- Originality, imagination and presentation of content
- Feasibility of proposal
