Frontier Airlines is Taking Its Talents to Cleveland! New Nonstop Service to Orlando and Seattle *Introductory fares as low as \$69* available only at FlyFrontier.com*

DENVER (Feb. 13, 2014) – Frontier Airlines today announced it will be taking its talents to the Cleveland area by expanding its ultra-low fare service at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport (CLE) with the addition of year-round nonstop service to Orlando, Fla. (MCO) and seasonal nonstop service to Seattle, Wash. (SEA), beginning June 13, 2014. To celebrate this announcement, Frontier is offering fares as low as \$69* each way to Orlando and \$119* each way to Seattle through Feb. 17, 2014 only at its website, FlyFrontier.com.

When service starts, Frontier Airlines will offer not one, not two, not three, but SIX destinations from Cleveland! Today, Frontier Airlines launches service to Trenton-Mercer Airport in Ewing, NJ, providing a convenient gateway to New Jersey and Southeast Pennsylvania, including the Philadelphia area. Frontier also provides nonstop service to its main hub in Denver, Colo. as well as nonstop service to both Cancun and Punta Cana in partnership with Apple Vacations. In June, frequency of service from Cleveland to Denver will increase from five flights per week to 12 flights per week.

"With the launch of service to Trenton-Mercer Airport today and the addition of these two routes in June, Northeast Ohioans now have an ultra-low fare option to get to both the east and west coast with Frontier," said Daniel Shurz, Frontier's senior vice president, commercial.

"We are extremely pleased Frontier is connecting Trenton to Cleveland today," said Airport Director Ricky Smith. "This is even a greater day for consumers as Frontier has announced they will add frequencies to their current Denver nonstop service and begin two new routes from CLE– Orlando and Seattle – Seattle is one of the markets we lost with United's decision to pull down the hub and Orlando is one of the region's top leisure markets. I want to thank Frontier for their confidence in Cleveland Hopkins and the Northeast Ohio region."

Depending on the fare type purchased, nonrefundable tickets may be transferred for a fee of up to \$50, or reissued for alternate flights for a fee of up to \$75, as well as a possible fare increase. The name change fee and itinerary change fee are not exclusive of each other. Previously purchased tickets may not be exchanged for these special fare tickets. Flight segment(s) must be cancelled prior to scheduled departure time or the ticket(s) and all monies will be forfeited.

Fares reflect purchase at FlyFrontier.com. Tickets purchased at FlyFrontier.com or by calling Frontier's reservations centers must be paid for at the time the reservation is made, but may be cancelled for a full refund without penalty up to 24 hours after the time of purchase.
