


ABOUT



inspiration and recreation, to the importance of life-giving water for the flowers, plants, and creatures of the earth.





essentially no cost. Now he takes his camera with him most weekends while exploring nature locally. Edward also relishes the opportunity to travel and to discover different eco-systems.





of things seen in travel and in everyday life that are too beautiful not to share with others. She is the mother of 4 grown children and is an avid boater.




