

Scope of Services

- Design and Construction of a new aesthetically pleasing canopy system over GTC.
- Maximize customer use area.
- Provide seating and customer queuing areas.
- Provide heated enclosed paths from existing building to customer pick up areas.
- Provide required lighting, signage, landscaping, sound systems, heating elements, etc. for best customer service.
- Provide new pavement, sidewalk and required drainage systems.
- > Demolish existing items, including walkway canopies and sidewalk system.



Items of Consideration

Design Consideration:

- Traffic consideration.
- Effective signage, including way-finding signage.
- Pick-up and drop-off operation that takes into account the safety of public and consumer impact.
- Weather Protection.

Items of Concern:

- > RTA Tunnel.
- Permanent structures (Tunnel opening and Electrical/HVAC equipment).
- Underground Structures (Pump Houses).
- Underground Utilities.

Environmental

Construction Storm Water Permit

- Greater than one acre disturbed will require storm water permit
- Must have recommendation of approval from CSWCD before construction commences

CLE Storm Water Master Plan

- PCBMP likely placed within work area
- Plant selection for USDA, FAA, City of Cleveland Redevelopment

Project Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan

- Inlet protection in plan must be what is used during construction.
- Documentation: training, inspections, corrective actions, etc.
- Site controls: concrete Washout, construction entrances, street sweeping, etc.
- CSWCD and DPC inspections

- > 20% of the total Ohio worker hours to be performed by Cleveland Residents
- 4% of the 20% to be performed by Cleveland Low Income Residents

Contractor and its subcontractors will be required to report certified payrolls into the LCPtracker system for Fannie Lewis requirements as well as prevailing wage

Codified in Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 4115

- > Laborers, workers, mechanics
- Helpers,
- Assistants
- > Apprentices
 - approved by the Ohio Apprenticeship State Council
 - registered in a apprenticeship program
 - Certifications are submitted to the Airport's PW Coordinator

Thereafter: Weekly if within 4 months



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Qualifications Selection Criteria

- ➤ Qualifications/Experience 15 points
- ➤ Project Approach 30 points
- ➤ Management Approach 25 points
- ➤ Key Staff 20 points
- Work Product Sample -10 points
- CSB/MBE/FBE Participation (Pass/Fail)



Scoring Procedure

➤ Qualifications – 50% of Total Score

➤ Fee Proposal – 50% of Total Score
